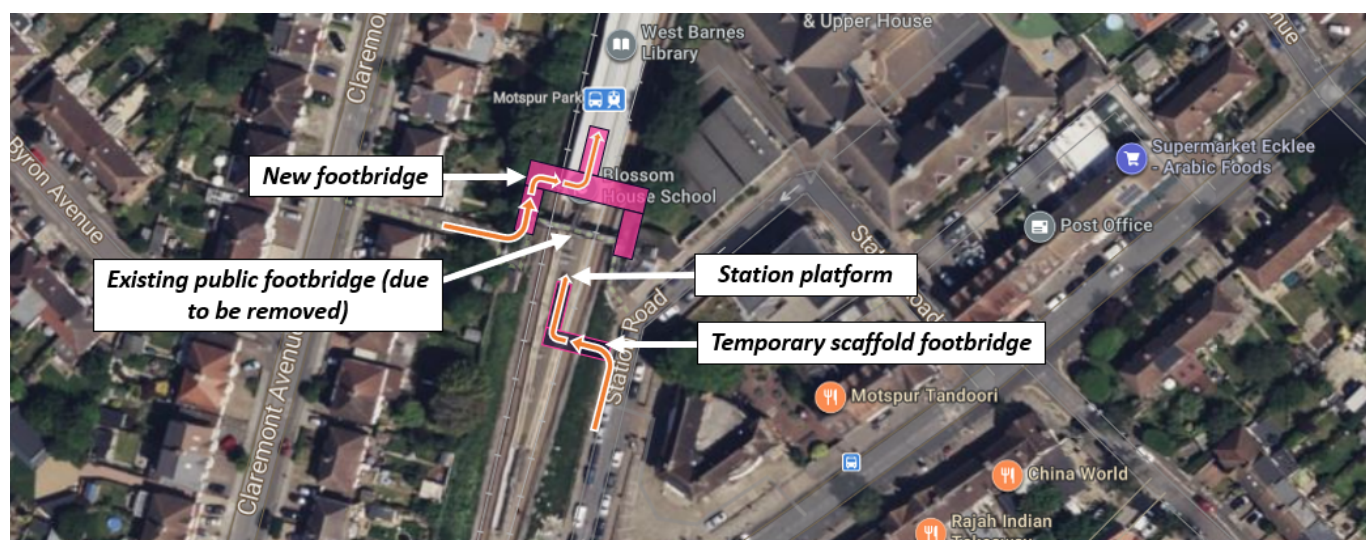


Railway improvement works – Access for All scheme at Motspur Park Station

As you may be aware, we've been carrying out essential improvement work in your area to install new lifts, stairs and a new footbridge at Motspur Park station. This work will provide step-free access across the station for the local community. Since our previous letter in April 2024, we would like to update you on the next phases of our work.

Phase 1; 7 –16 June: Following the installation of the bridge spans and lift shafts, we are due to remove the remaining section of the existing public footbridge located on the West side of the station adjacent to Claremont Avenue. A crane will be **used** to complete these works which will be positioned within the site compound. **New stairs and a bridge will be installed** to allow members of the public to access the station platform from Claremont Avenue as seen below. This work including installation of lifts will take place from 7 to 16 June. Access to the station via the East side (temporary scaffold footbridge) will remain open.



Phase 2; 23-24 June: The temporary scaffold bridge located on the East side will be removed to allow full commissioning of the new stairs and footbridge. This will take place on Sunday 23 June which involves a closure of the track. We'll be using specialist equipment designed to minimise the noise we create however some of our equipment and machinery may cause some noise disturbance during Sunday daytime and you'll notice some increased traffic from delivery vehicles. Every effort will be made to minimise any excessive noise while this work is carried out.

Work will take place as follows (when trains are not running):

| Date | Time | Work to be carried out |
|--|---|---|
| Continued night working (Monday – Saturday) | 23:00 – 05:00 | Preparation works and deliveries (transporting of materials to island platforms), retaining wall construction |
| Friday 7 June 2024 to Sunday 16 June 2024 | 23:00-04:00 continuous | Crane mobilisation, public footbridge removal, crane demobilisation - overnight and daytime work |
| Sunday 23 June 2024 – Monday 24 June 2024 | 00:00-03:00 (27 hours) Continuous | Removal of scaffold footbridge and stairs |
